

Zubin Mehta wins Dan David prize

Tel Aviv, March 9: India-born music conductor Zubin Mehta has won the prestigious Dan David prize for 2007 for outstanding contribution in his field. Mehta is the second Indian to receive the award after Prof C N R Rao won it in 2005 for his contribution to the field of material sciences.

The one million dollar award is given annually in three different fields - archaeology, performing arts and material science - in the three dimension time framework of past, present and future. The prize is awarded jointly by Tel Aviv University and the Dan David Foundation.
