A Documentary History of the Jews in Italy by Shlomo Simonsohn,
Professor of Jewish History in the University of Tel Aviv.

Established to sponsor documentation and research of the history of the Jews in Italy, its purpose is to locate, identify and research documentary material pertaining to the history of the Jews in Italy and to publish the results systematically.

Hitherto, 25 volumes have appeared and another 8 are awaiting publication. They deal with the history of the Jews in Piedmont, Genoa, Rome, Umbria, Milan and Sicily. The volumes currently in print describe the history of the Jews in Sicily. Volume 11 (= 25 of the series) has appeared recently and volume 12 (= 26 of the series) will be published shortly.
